Along with Jäger and I, we had several riders with outstanding results in the summer shows. Megan Terrazas, Kelly Terrazas & Allie DeSimone racked up the ribbons at the **Blenheim Racing Festival** in July. They received championship ribbons and competed with some of the very best riders and held their own! These girls can ride!

They also competed in the **Blenheim August Festival** the following week along with Mark Green/Xander. All four enjoyed the show and had great results. This particular week is not as busy as the previous and allows the horse and rider to relax more. They even set up the Grand Prix arena for lower level jumpers to experience the feel of the large arena. I am so proud of all of you! Great job!

BARN RULES & REMINDERS:

- *Please make sure you're not taking anyone's personal tack when you're tacking up a horse.* Many of the clients have had pads removed from under their personal saddles, bridles and martingales missing from the hook that's labeled with their horses name and other items borrowed and not returned. Please ask permission if you need to borrow any tack.
- We have also had some issues with feed and supplements. Please remember to ask if you've run out of something and need to borrow. Please don't help yourself to any feed/supplements not marked with your horses name. We would like to keep the honor system in place.
- Please put any misplaced items in either LOST & FOUND bin (located in both tack rooms).
- Please remember you are responsible for the horse you ride and all the tack you've used. Clean everything and return everything to it's place (including the horse).
